Analysts will (1) provide support (if assigned) for special reports and projects undertaken by the office, (2) general support for all major and regular reports issued by the office and (3) take part in the rotation of duties for regular daily and monthly reports published/transmitted by the office.

- ➤ Possession of a bachelor's degree or higher with a major course of study in economics, finance, mathematics, statistics or related field that requires extensive quantitative analysis. Relevant work experience may substitute for a degree in one of the specified fields. Applicants should have an overall GPA of 3.2 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- > Ability to perform quantitative analysis and manipulate datasets. Knowledge of econometrics is a plus.
- > Ability to clearly and succinctly convey economic, statistical and financial concepts verbally and in writing in a manner that is appropriate for the intended audience.
- Motivation to improve analytical methods and seek out new and unique data sources.
- > Ability to meet deadlines and manage time efficiently.
- > Proficiency with Microsoft Excel. The ability to use statistical software (e.g., SAS or Stata) is a plus.
